**To:** All Users of MWFP Roads

**Re:** Daytime Spring Road Ban between 10 am and 10 pm, Effective March 15, 2019

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Please be advised that effective 10:00 am on Friday, March 15, 2019, all roads owned or operated by Millar Western Forest Products (MWFP) will be CLOSED during the hours of 10:00 am to 10:00 pm to all traffic over 1 tonne.

Therefore only NIGHT HAUL IS ALLOWED.

The daytime road ban will be in effect until further notice and applies to ALL roads owned or operated by Millar Western Forest Products, including but not limited to:

Roads are to be used under DRY or FROZEN conditions, as is our policy all year long. It is your responsibility to notify all field staff, contractors, sub-contractors and other employees covered under your road-use agreement.

Your co-operation in limiting damage to MWFP roads during the break-up period is very much appreciated.

**Any companies anticipating required fluid removal through the Road Ban Period must apply for a Spring Conditions Road Use Agreement.**

Road users are also reminded that valid road use agreement(s) must be in place prior to using MWFP roads.

The following will assist in determining what type of agreement you must have in place/or need to request, prior to using the roads.

- Short-term Road Use: Use of MWFP DLO(s) for the purpose of heavy (over 3 Ton), short-term use. Examples include: drilling/service rigs, water/cement/vacuum trucks, Pickers, construction equipment moves, etc.
- Long-term Road Use: Use of MWFP DLO(s) for the purposes of ongoing site maintenance throughout the year. Intended for light use (under 3 Ton) (pick up access to sites connected to a pipeline) or heavy use (over 3 Ton) (sites that require regular fluid removal or are not connected to a pipeline), servicing major pipelines or powerlines.
- Special Conditions: Use of MWFP DLO (s) that does not fall into the above categories. Emergency access during unfavorable road conditions, access during road ban periods for fluid removal.
